English - L.O. To understand how to make complex sentences using adverbials.

Complex Sentences - Using Adverbials

An adverbial is a group of words that are used in the same way as an adverb. We can make more interesting complex sentences by using these to give us more information. For example - Before the play, we went out for tea. Before the play, is the adverbial. It is divided off from the rest of the sentence by a comma.

Here are some adverbials. Copy them out and complete the sentences so they make sense.
